



Laxmi Bai was the queen of Jhansi. Her <u>struggle</u> with the British is <u>legendary</u>. The <u>battle</u> began early in June 1857. Sir Hugh Rose <u>captured</u> the fortress of Jhansi in March 1858. Rani Laxmi Bai <u>resisted</u> but Jhansi was captured by the British when traitors opened the gates of the fortress for them. On the night of 4th of April 1858, she <u>escaped</u> from the fortress and joined Tantia Tope at Kalpi. Rani Lakshmi Bai and Tantia Tope captured the fort of Gwalior from Sindhia. She died fighting the British on 17th of June 1858 at Gwalior.
